PERFORMING SECTION

- Do I know the title of my play and my playwright?
- Have I understood the overall “feel” and mood of my piece?
- Am I being my character all the way through?
- Am I moving like my character all the way through?
- Are all my words clean and clear?
- Am I loud enough?
- What are the important words in the sentence?
- Am I breathing so I can speak without running out of puff?
- Am I leaving enough time for my unseen characters to reply to me?
- Are my mimes believable?
- Am I reacting to my unseen characters?
- Am I pausing so I can react to what is happening?
- Why do I move across the stage? **(NOT BECAUSE RUTHIE TOLD YOU TO!)**
- When do I want the audience to laugh? How can I make them do this?
- Am I thinking of other things whilst I am performing or am I focused all the way through?
